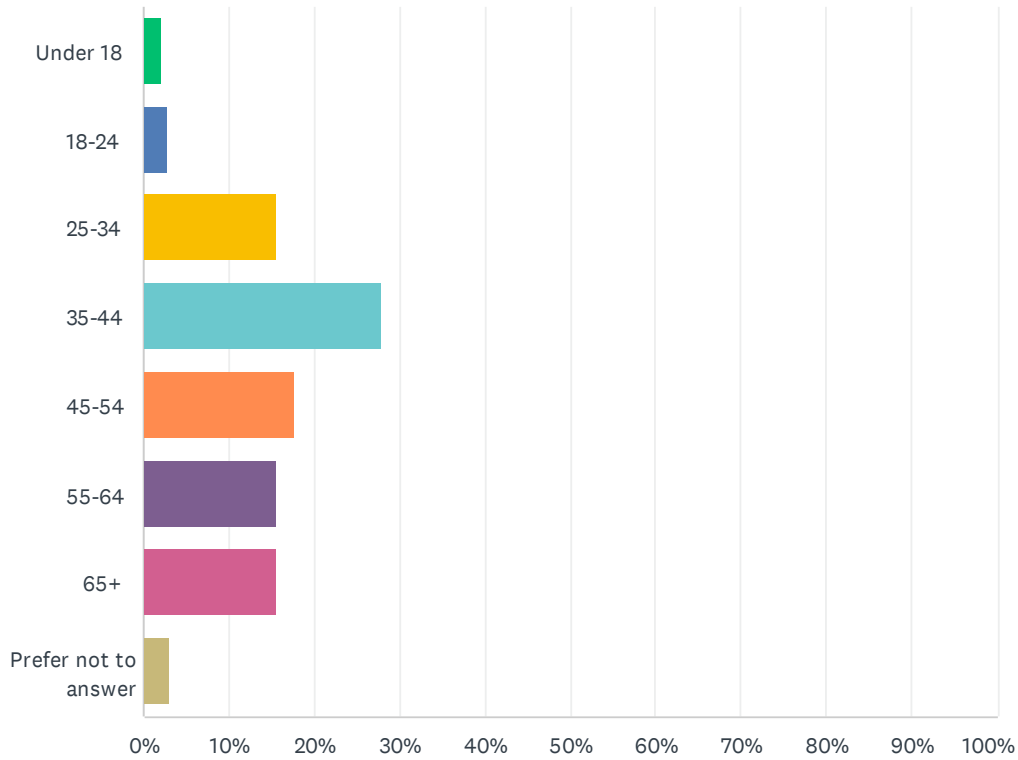


Q1 What is your age?

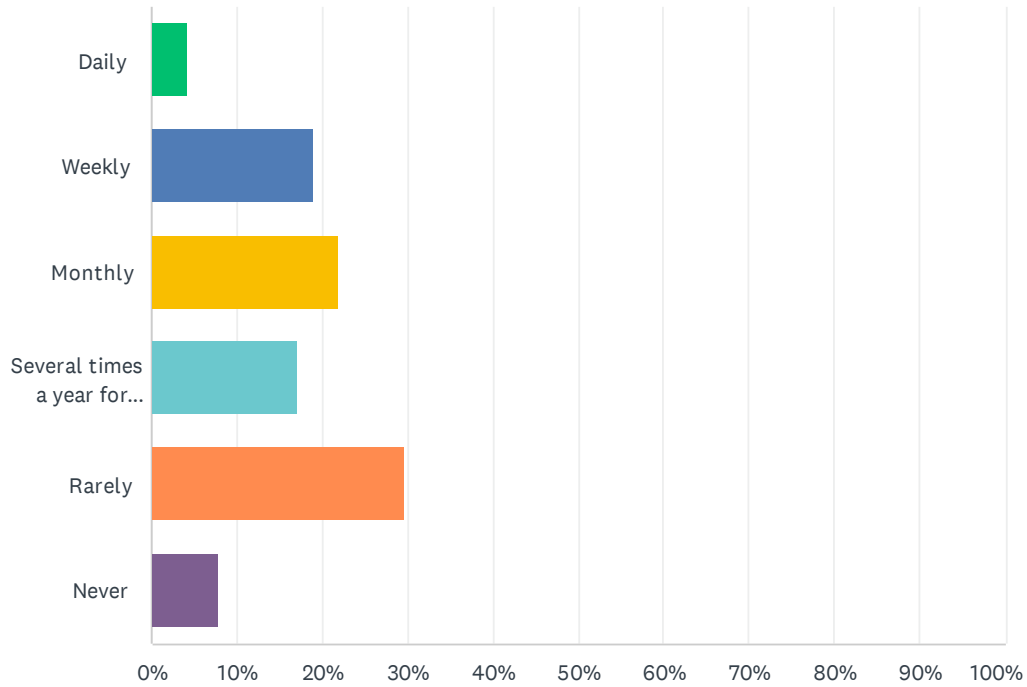

Q3 How often do you visit the park?

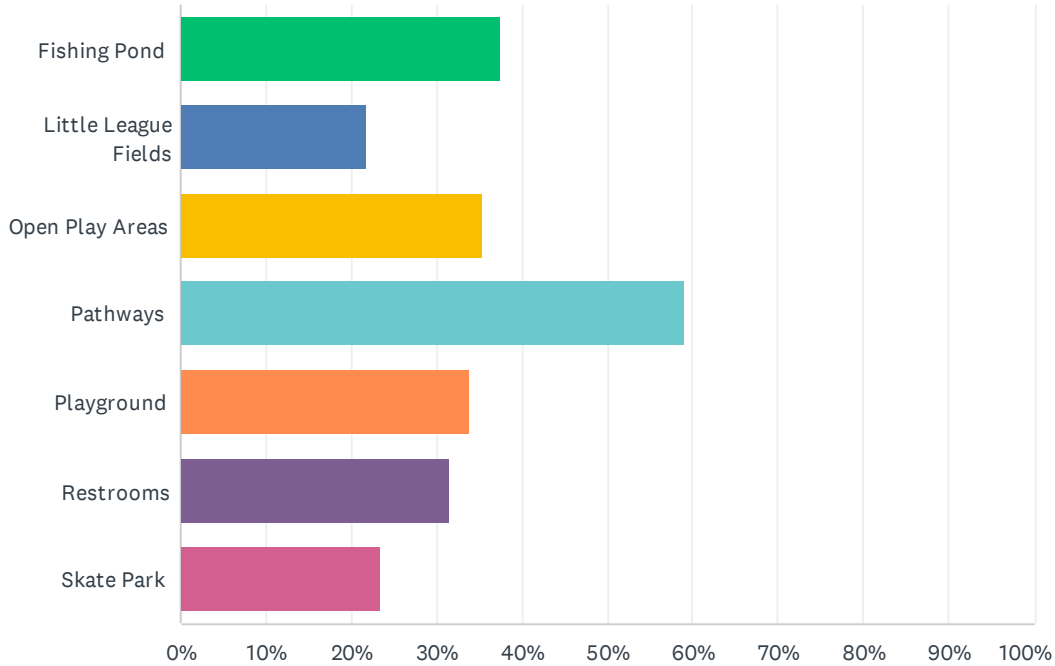

Q4 What current amenities do you enjoy when visiting Charles F. McDevitt Youth Sports Complex? Select all that apply.

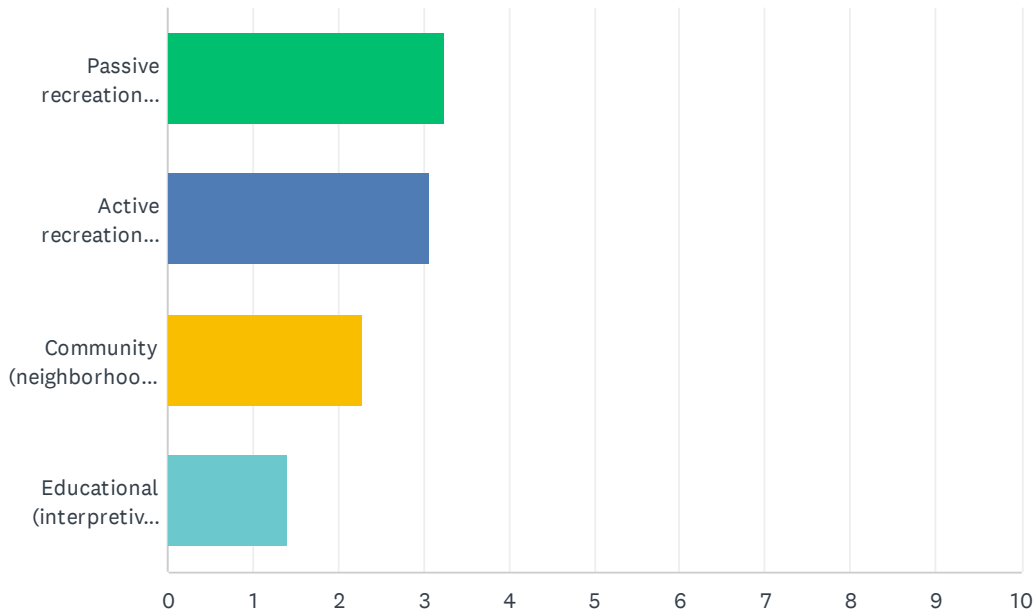

Q5 What kind of experiences are you and your family looking for when visiting Charles F. McDevitt Youth Sports Complex? Please rank in order of most desired to least desired.

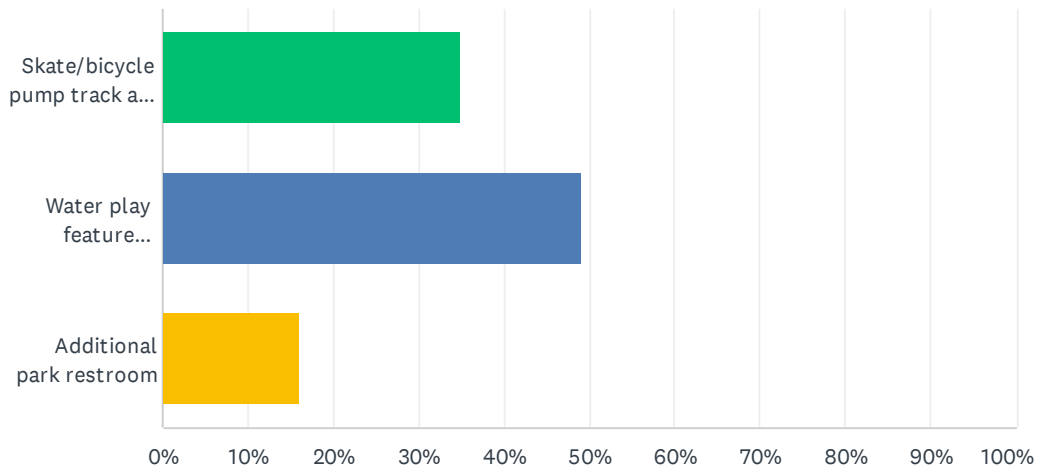

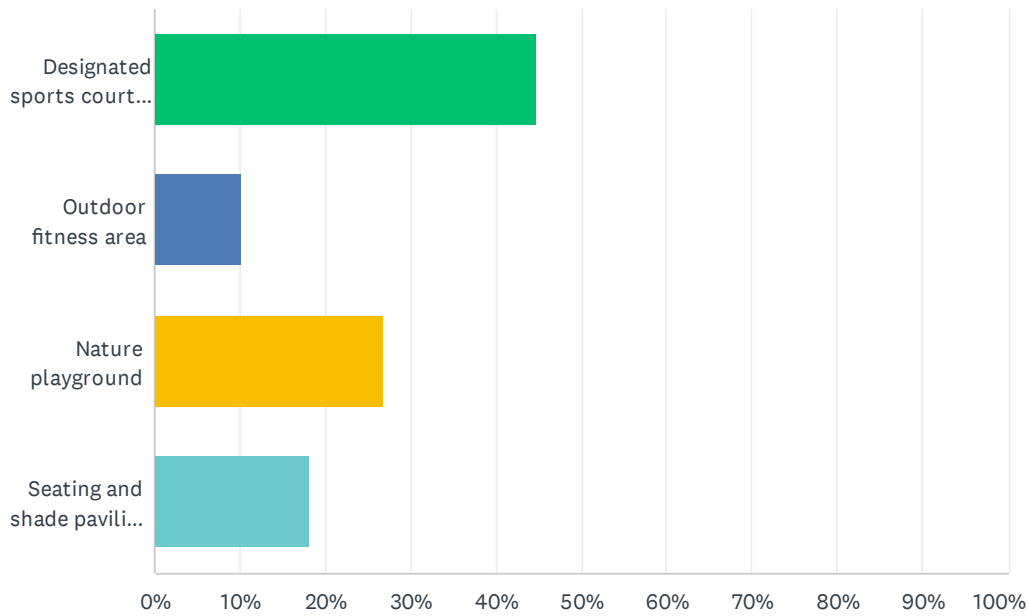

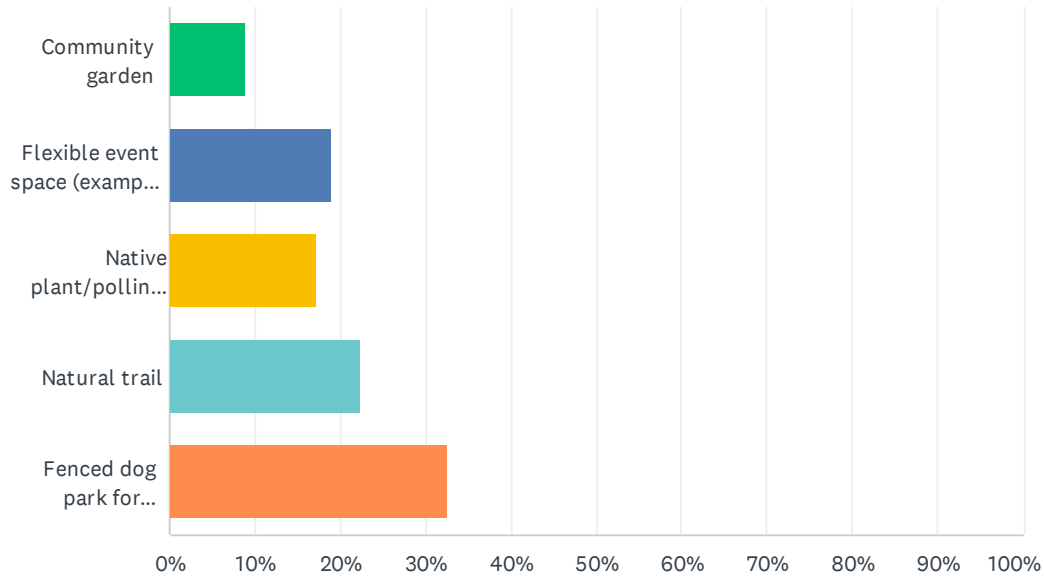
