CONDUCT A WASTE AUDIT

SET INTERNAL WASTE REDUCTION GOALS

• Establish specific, measurable targets for reducing office waste and regularly track progress to motivate employees and demonstrate commitment to waste reduction.

ESTABLISH AN OFFICE GREEN TEAM

• Form a group of employees dedicated to promoting and implementing sustainability initiatives within the office, fostering a culture of environmental responsibility and waste reduction.

ENGAGE CUSTODIAL STAFF

 Train custodial staff to properly separate recyclables from trash to ensure materials are correctly sorted and diverted from landfills.

POST SIGNAGE ON WASTE CONTAINERS

• Clearly label all waste, recycling, and organics bins with signage to help employees correctly dispose of their waste, reducing contamination and improving recycling rates.

DONATE EXCESS FOOD

• Give leftover breakroom snacks, beverages, or food from office parties to local food pantries or shelters, reducing food waste and supporting the community.

SET UP AN OFFICE "SHARING CORNER"

 Create a designated area where employees can share unused office supplies, books, or other commonly used items, promoting reuse and reducing the need for new purchases.

REDUCE PRINTER PAPER AND PAPER TOWEL USE

• Encourage digital alternatives to printing and install efficient hand dryers to cut down on paper towel use, significantly lowering paper consumption in the office.
